## CALIFORNIA WILDFIRE RESTORATION

The DUCTZ National Service Team (NST) responded to an emergency call to help restore the indoor air quality after wildfires forced evacuation of homes, schools, businesses and recreational facilities in southern California. Immediately after fire officials released the building for safe entry, the DUCTZ NST response team began assessing impacted HVAC and mechanical systems.
